INTENDED USE

The ISOPOP is intended to be used as a mountable pop filter for professional vocal recording. The ISOPOP is intended to be used on standard microphone stands. The ISOPOP should only be used in households, normal recording studios or similar environments.

The product shall only be used according to the instructions as described in this manual. All use other than described in this manual is seen as unintended use. This will also invalidate the warranty.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

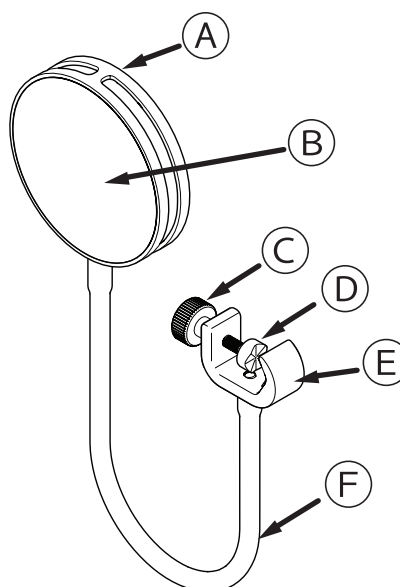
WARNING

- Always keep the instructions for future reference. The information in this manual is subject to change without notice.

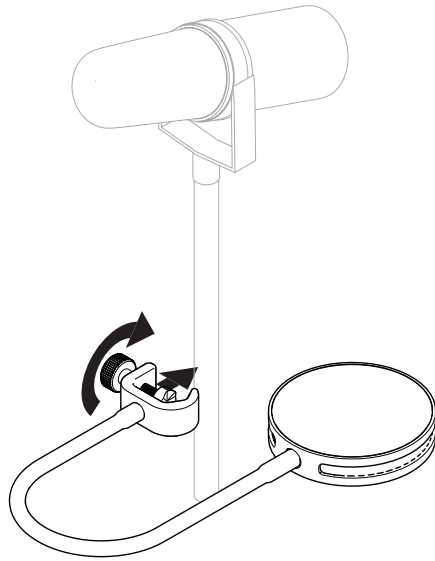
PRODUCT ELEMENTS

- a. Housing
- b. Pop filter
- c. Thumbscrew
- d. Pin holder
- e. Clamp
- f. Neck



HOW TO USE THE ISOPOP

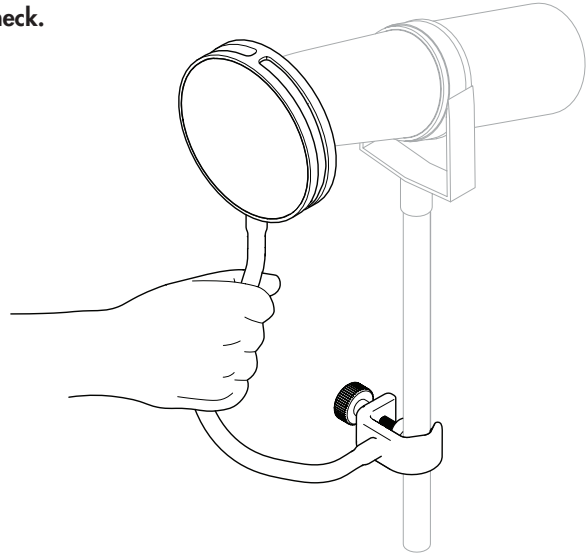
1. Loosen the **thumbscrew** (C) and put the **clamp** (E) around a **microphone stand** (not included). Tighten the **thumbscrew** (C) to safely attach the **ISOPOP** to a **microphone stand**.



2. Put the **pop filter** (B) in front of the **microphone** (not included) by articulating the **neck** (F).

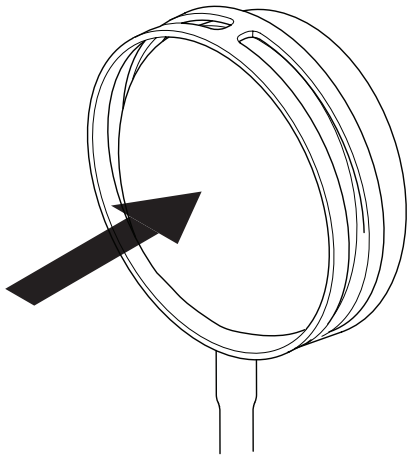
NOTICE

Carefully articulate the neck. Using too much force may break the neck.

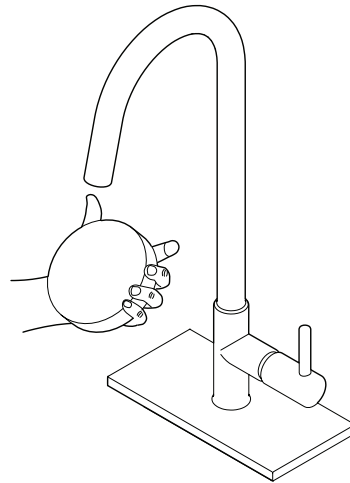


HOW TO CLEAN THE ISOPOP

1. Push the **pop filter** (B) out of the **housing** (A).



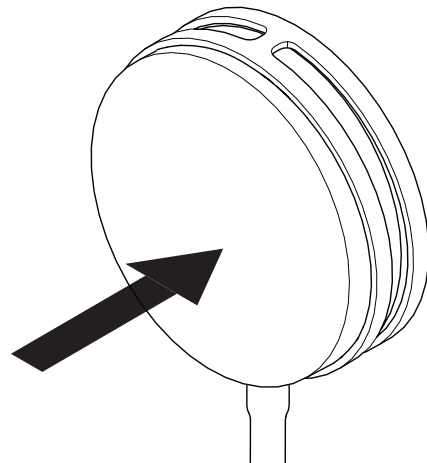
2. Clean the **pop filter** (B) with water under a faucet.



3. Wring the **pop filter** (B) out and leave it to dry.
4. Push the **pop filter** (B) back into the **housing** (A).

NOTICE

Make sure the pop filter is dry before pushing it back into the housing. Water may drip onto the microphone and cause damage.
