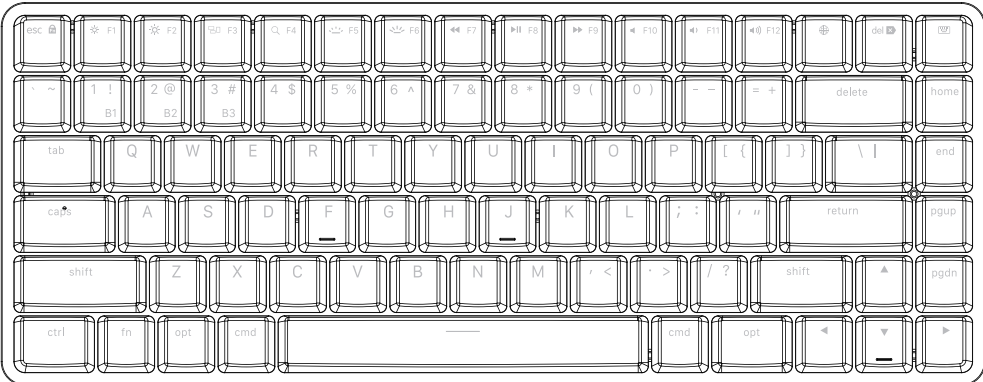

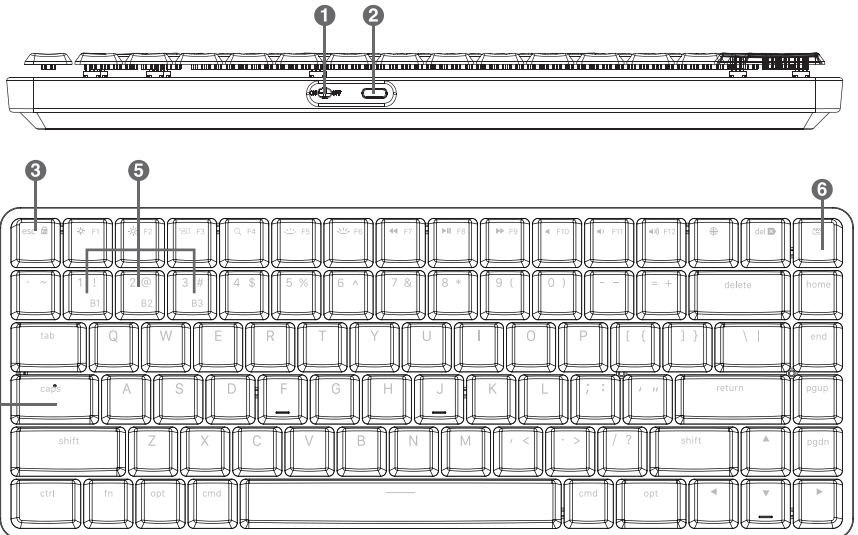
PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Keyboard
- USB-A to USB-C charging cable

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Bluetooth enabled computer, Mac, iPad, iPhone, laptop, mobile phone or tablet.
- Laptop, desktop with an available USB-A port for charging the keyboard.
- USB-A wall charger for charging the keyboard (alternative if your laptop/desktop does not have a USB-A port).

HARDWARE BASICS



USB-C charging cable

1.On/Off Switch

2.USB-C Charging Port

3.FN LED (On Esc key)

- White or off – Shortcut mode active
- Green – Shortcut mode inactive

4.CAPS LOCK

- White or off – Caps lock inactive
- Green – Caps lock active

5.B1 LED

- Flashing Green – Pairing mode.
- White or off - Connected.

B2 LED

- Flashing Green – Pairing mode.
- White or off - Connected.

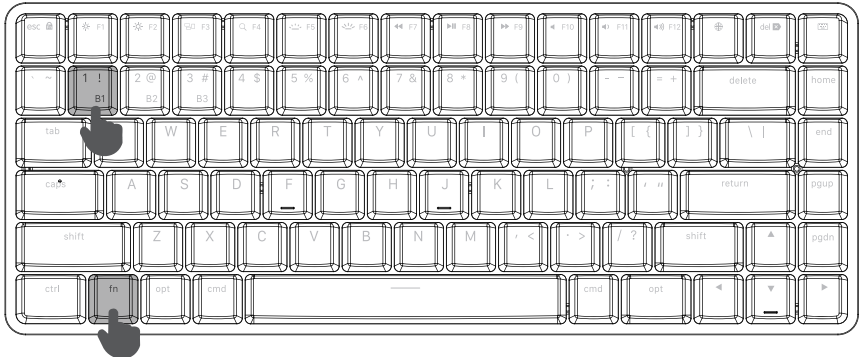
B3 LED

- Flashing Green – Pairing mode.
- White or off - Connected.

6.CHARGING LED (On Keyboard key)

- Green – Charging
- White or off - Full

BLUETOOTH PAIRING INSTRUCTIONS



Take a look at the numbers 1 through 3. They are labeled B1, B2, and B3. These are the 3 Bluetooth channels that are used to pair the keyboard to your devices.

To pair your keyboard to a Bluetooth enabled device (Computer, Laptop, Phone, tablet) make sure the keyboard is on and charged, then follow the steps below:

NOTE

We will use Bluetooth channel 1 (B1) in these steps.

1. Open the Bluetooth settings on the device you are pairing the keyboard to (laptop, desktop, tablet, phone, etc).
2. **Press and hold both fn and number 1 key (B1) together for 2 seconds, until B1 starts to blink green.**
3. Click/tap on the keyboard input device name BTBLMxSMINI that shows up on your screen to pair the keyboard. Once paired, the B1 LED should go off.

To pair the keyboard to a second device all you have to do is follow the same steps above for the other two Bluetooth channels (B2 & B3).

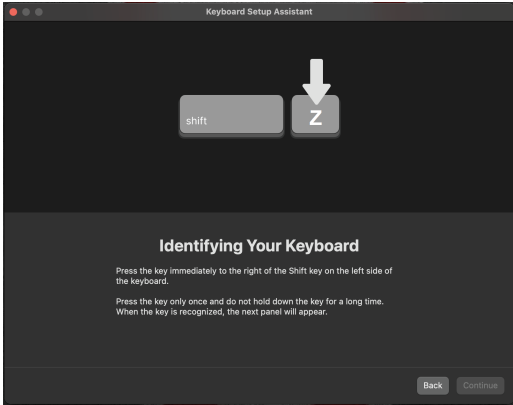
NOTE

The green light on the number 1, 2, and 3 will go off after 3 blinks to indicate successful Bluetooth connection. This is for saving power consumption.

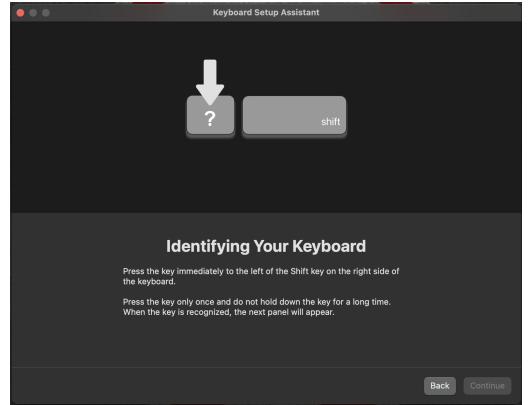
KEYBOARD SETUP ASSISTANT (MAC USER'S)

When you pair a keyboard that is not immediately recognized, the macOS Keyboard Setup Assistant automatically opens so that you can specify the keyboard type. Please follow the onscreen instructions when prompted.

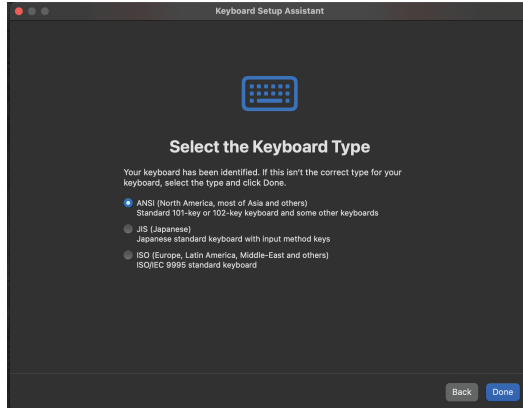
STEP1: Press the Z key



STEP2: Press the ? key



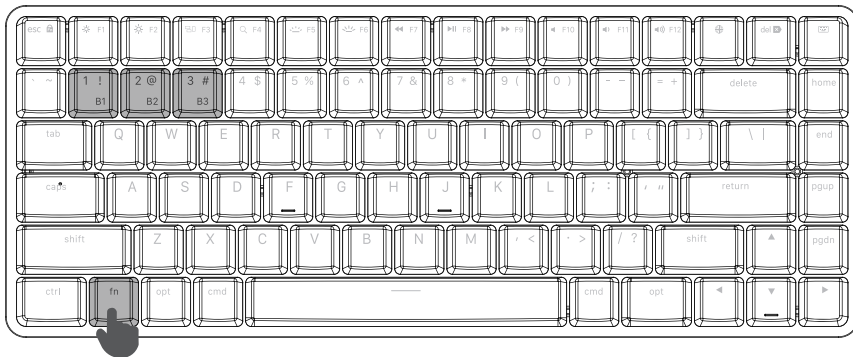
STEP2: Select your keyboard type (ANSI)



If the Keyboard Setup Assistant did not popup and you are having issues with keys not responding or typing letters other than what's printed on the them you will need to launch the setup assistant manually by doing the following:

1. Open your System Settings or System Preferences.
2. Select Keyboard, then look for and click "Change Keyboard Type".
3. When you see the Keyboard Setup Assistant window, click Continue and follow onscreen instructions as shown in the image above.

SWITCHING BETWEEN MULTIPLE DEVICES

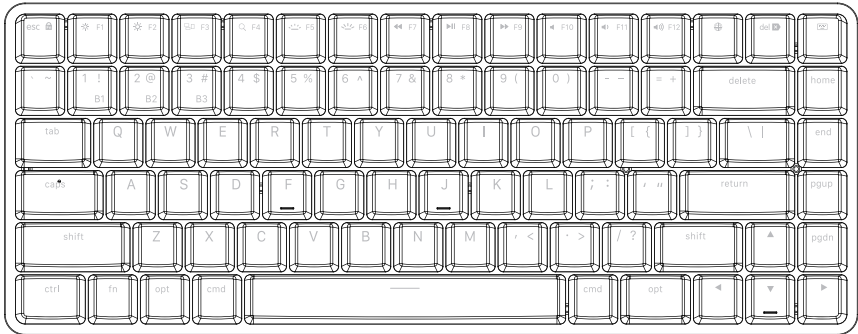


Once you have all your devices paired to the keyboard, switching between multiple devices can be done by simply holding the fn key and pressing any of the 3 Bluetooth keys (1, 2, 3) you want to switch to.

NOTE

Do not hold the number 1, 2, and 3 for more than 1 second. It will forget its paired device to start a new pairing. Reconnect time may vary depending on the connected devices Bluetooth version.

CHARGING THE KEYBOARD



To charge the keyboard simply plug the USB-A end of the cable provided into any available USB-A port on your computer, laptop or USB wall charger and insert the USB-C end of the cable into the USB-C port located along the top right-hand side of the keyboard.

NOTE

Using the cable only charges the keyboard. It does not convert the keyboard into a “wired” device.

Battery LED (On the keyboard icon key, in the upper right corner):















- Green when charging
- Off when full

SHORTCUTS & FUNCTION KEYS

The keyboards top F-row is defaulted to boot up under shortcut mode (small icons and text printed on the F-row keys) brightness control, volume control, search, etc. To utilize any of the standard function keys (F1, F2, etc) simply hold the fn key followed by the function key you wish to execute.

NOTE

You can switch the F-row from shortcuts to functions F1-F12 at any time by pressing fn+esc, Fn lock LED(esc key) will light in green. When switched, you can still utilize the shortcuts by holding down the fn key followed by the shortcut you would like to perform. You can always switch the keyboard back to shortcut mode by pressing fn+esc again.

Shortcuts	Function
fn+esc	Switches the keyboard from shortcut mode to function mode as described in the above note. (Also Fn Lock LED)
F1 	Decreases the brightness level on the screen. Please note that not all external monitors support this function.
F2 	Increases the brightness level on the screen. Please note that not all external monitors support this function.
F3 	Mission control.
F4 	Search
F5 	Decrease the keyboard backlight brightness.
F6 	Increase the keyboard backlight brightness.
F7 	Back/Previous track.
F8 	Play/Pause.
F9 	Forward/Next track.
F10 	Mute.
F11 	Volume down.
F12 	Volume up.

BATTERY & BACKLIGHT USAGE

This keyboard includes a built-in 2000 mAh Li-Ion rechargeable battery. When the backlight is not used at all, a fully charged battery will last up to approximately 3 months.

It is important to note, however, that the backlight consumes a lot of energy. For the purpose of saving battery power, the keyboard's backlight is automatically turned off at different inactivity time increments based on the set brightness level.

- Brightest level: 30 seconds
- Medium level: 60 seconds
- Low level: 120 seconds

The backlight will automatically turn back on when typing resumes. Typically, a fully charged battery is adequate for up to 2 weeks of backlight use. It may be a good idea to turn on the backlight only at night or in low light environments in order to extend the battery life.

When the battery level is low, keyboard icon key(charge indicator LED) will flash green, so please charge the keyboard using the USB cable provided. The keyboard can still be used while it is charging.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Not all shortcuts are universal and may act differently on certain devices.
- All standard function keys (F1-F12) have a special function defined by the connected operating system, or by a currently running program.
