The Oben TT-1120 mini tabletop tripod is a substantial aluminum tripod that will provide a compact and secure platform for a variety of tabletop applications.

An 11-pound weight capacity makes this tripod compatible with a range of devices from smartphones to full-featured DSLRs. The included ballhead is outfitted with an Arca-compatible quick-release plate for rapid camera mounting and swapping. Nonskid rubber feet hold the tripod steady without slipping on uneven or highly polished surfaces.

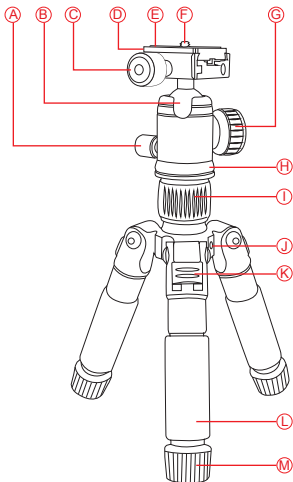
Adjustable legs and center column provide a 13-inch height range for precise positioning on your desktop. And the dual-action ballhead, with its independent pan lock, accommodates speedy camera positioning. The legs fold up to a compact 7.2 inches for easy transport and convenient storage.

**Warnings:**

- *Do not exceed the tripod's maximum load capacity (see Specifications).*
- *Ensure that all appropriate locks are engaged when necessary.*
- *This tripod should be used only in temperatures between -22°F and 140°F (-30°C and 60°C).*

- *Always support your device or camera with one hand while reaiming the camera or adjusting the height.*

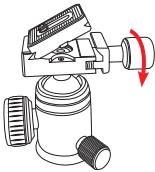

## OVERVIEW

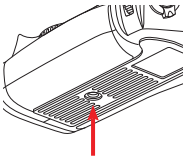


- (A)** Pan lock

## Mounting a Camera to the TT-1120



1. Turn the quick-release knob counterclockwise to open the quick-release clamp and remove the quick-release plate from the clamp.



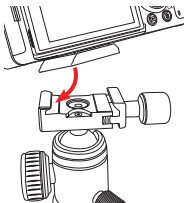
2. Screw the quick-release plate into the bottom of the camera.



3. Use the D-ring, a slotted screwdriver, or a coin to tighten the screw into the camera's socket.

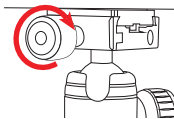
## OPERATION

4. Mount the camera to the ballhead by sliding one edge of the quick-release plate into the clamp. Then lower the other side until the quick-release plate is lying flat in the clamp.



**Note:** Make sure the mounting screw's D-ring is flush with the bottom of the plate.

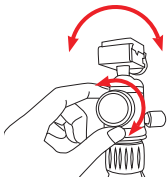
4. Turn the quick-release knob clockwise to lock the plate in place.



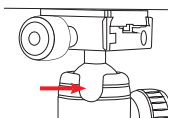
**Warning:** Some manufacturers' plates do not meet our specifications and may not lock your equipment securely in the Oben quick-release clamp. Test any camera and lens plates made by manufacturers other than Oben to ensure compatibility before use.

## Ballhead Operation

### BALLHEAD LOCKING KNOB



The ballhead locking knob locks and unlocks the ballhead, which allows for changing the camera position.

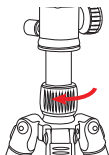


Use the 90° notch to quickly switch between landscape and portrait orientations.

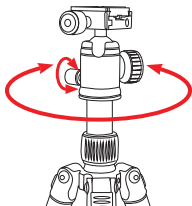
**Important!** Always use one hand to secure the camera while adjusting the ballhead and be sure the lock is engaged before letting go of the camera.

### PANORAMIC BASE

1. Make sure the center column is securely tightened so that it doesn't slip.



2. Twist the pan lock counterclockwise to loosen the base and turn the base to the desired position.

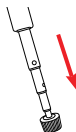


3. Twist the pan lock clockwise to tighten until secure.

## Leg Length Adjustment



1. Turn the foot counterclockwise by a notch to loosen each leg segment.



2. Adjust the leg to the desired length.



3. Turn the foot clockwise to lock the leg.

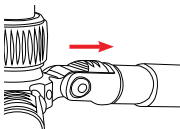
**Note:** Turn the foot counterclockwise by four notches to unlock all segments simultaneously. Extend the leg to its maximum length or decrease the leg to its minimum length in one motion.

## OPERATION

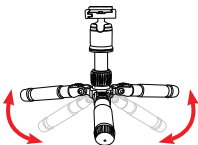
### Leg Angle Adjustment

Each leg can be adjusted to three preset angles.

1. Press the leg angle lock down to unlock the leg angle.

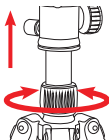


2. Spread or close the legs to the desired angle. Make sure the leg lock clicks into place to prevent slipping.

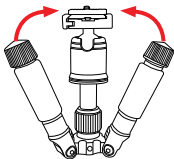


### Folding Up the TT-1120 for Travel and Storage

1. Extend the center column to its maximum height and tighten the center column lock.



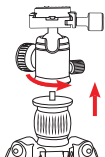
2. Unlock the leg angle locks and fold the legs all the way up.



## Removing the Ballhead from the Tripod



1. Turn the center column lock clockwise to tighten it until secure.



2. Unscrew the ballhead from the tripod.
