# Introduction

## Thank you for choosing Impact.

The Impact 4-Roll Motorized Background Support allows you to remotely lower and raise multiple backgrounds from behind the camera. Store up to four backgrounds weighing up to 15 pounds for your next fashion or corporate photo shoot. There are 16 wireless channels to help minimize cross-signal interference from surrounding electronic devices.

## Precautions ⚠

- When installing this product, be sure to refer to the mounting instructions detailed in this manual; failure to abide by the mounting instructions may void the product's warranty.
- This product has been designed specifically for mounting directly to studs, joists, or other structural elements; depending on wall type and material, the use of additional appropriate mounting hardware and/or accessories such as heavy-duty anchors may be required.
- Do not use this product for any background rolls other than what it is intended for; the exact specifications, size parameters, and weight limits are found both on the product box and in the instruction manual.
- It is strongly recommended that this product be installed by a qualified professional or installation contractor; Impact takes no responsibility for any product damage or personal injury resulting from mishandling, incorrect mounting, faulty assembly, or improper use of this product.

- The supplied mounting hardware is not intended for use on metal studs, concrete, or cinder block walls and may not be appropriate for old or weak walls; it is best to consult with a qualified professional to determine whether your wall can support this bracket.

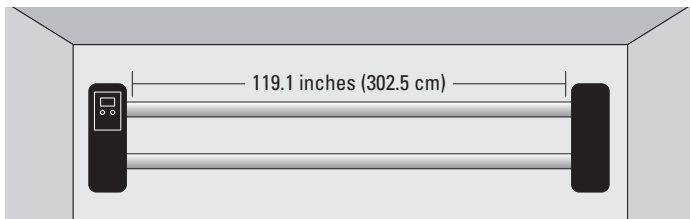

# Setup

## Attachment to a Wall or Ceiling

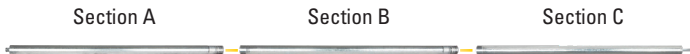
Secure the housing units to the structural supports in the walls or ceilings, using all eight lag bolts.

Make sure the distance between the housing units is 119 inches (for the SBP-9R) so there's enough space to install the crossbars.

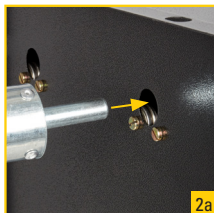


## Installing the Crossbars

1. Assemble the crossbars by screwing the three pieces together. After the crossbar is assembled, insert it into your background paper roll.



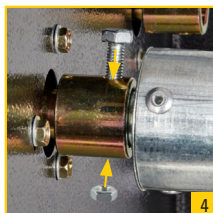
2. Insert the Section C into the crossbar housing so that the crossbar sticks out through the other side.



3. Align Section A with the holes in the motorized housing, and insert the crossbar.



4. Insert a bolt through the hole, and secure with a nut.
