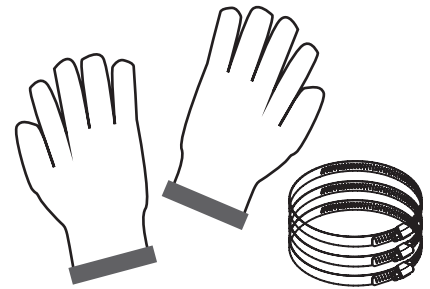
#### Step 1: Prepare for Installation



**A)** Choose a suitable pole within the bracket's compatible diameter range.

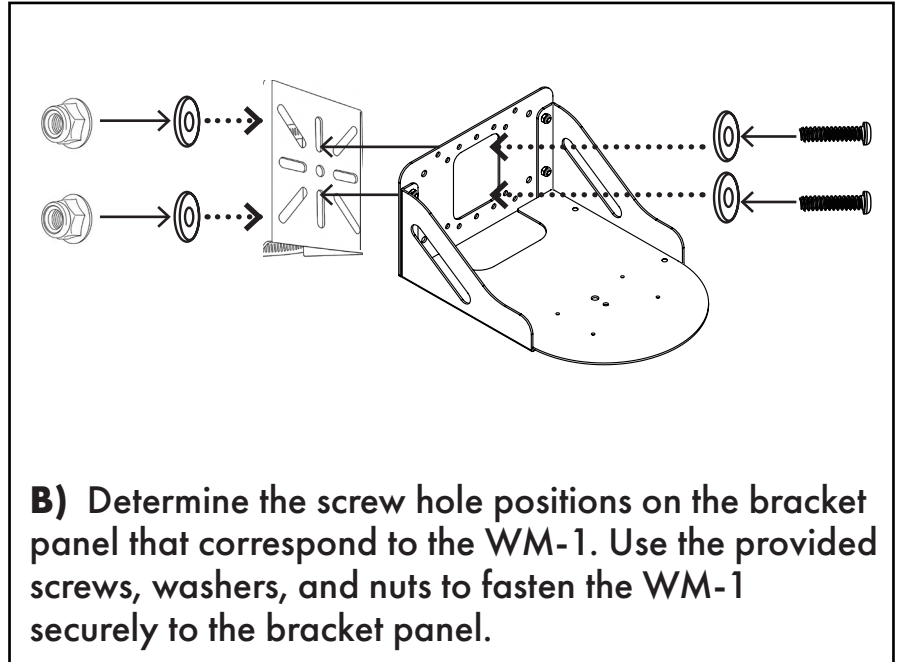
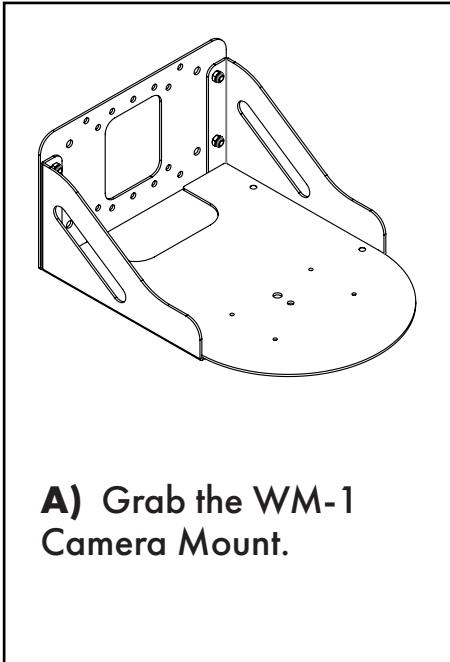


**B)** Ensure the surface is clean and free from debris for stable installation.

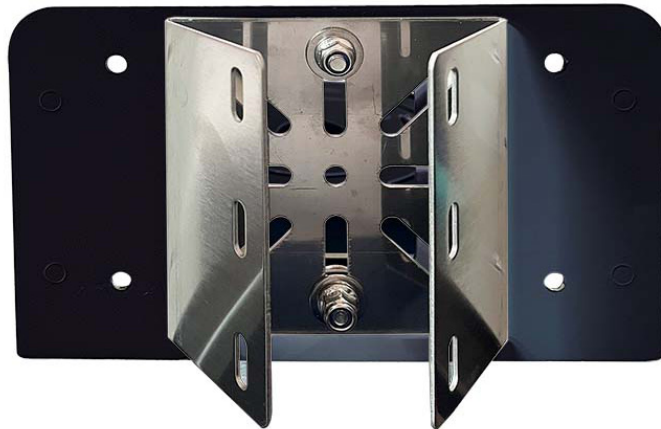


**C)** Wear protective gloves before handling the stainless-steel loops.

## Step 2: Attach the WM-1 to Bracket



**Mounting should look like this.**

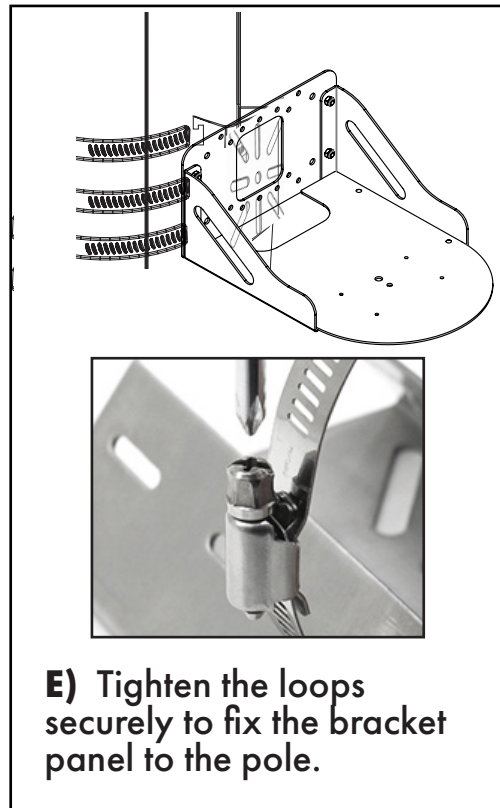
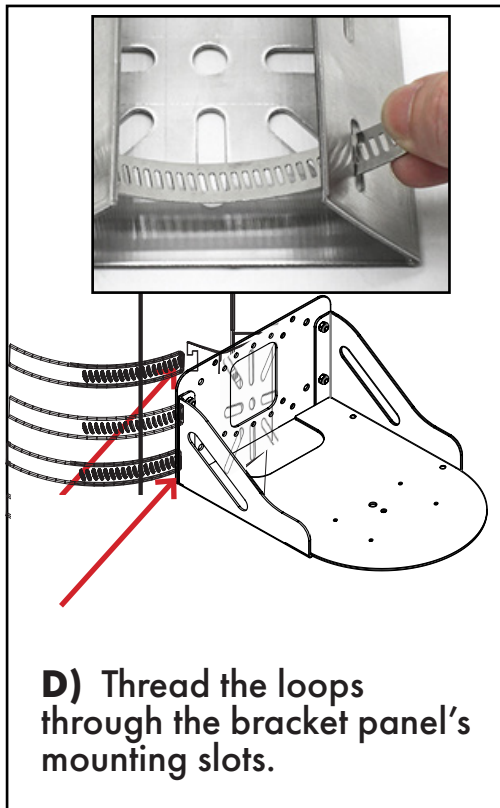
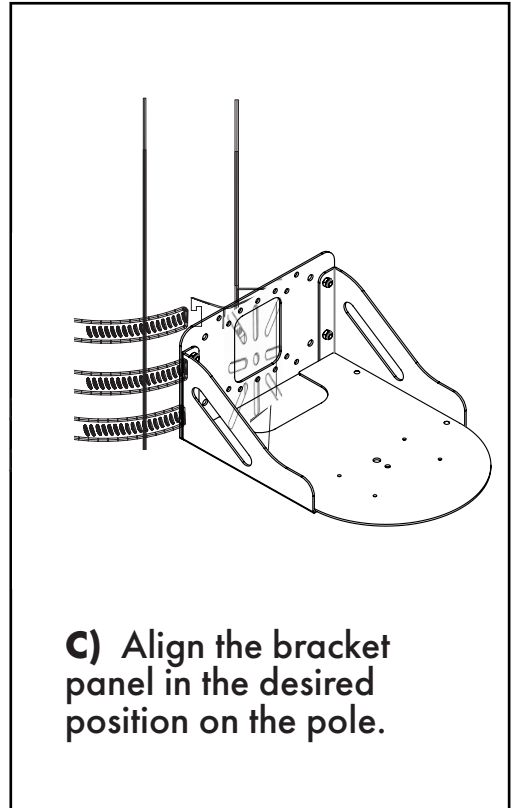
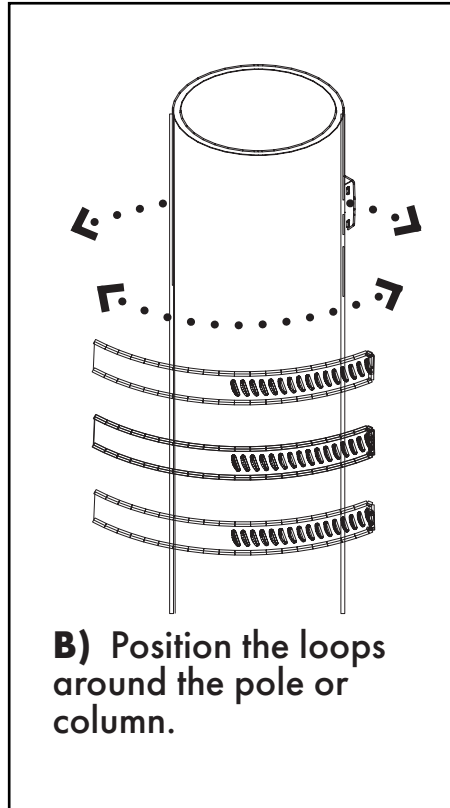
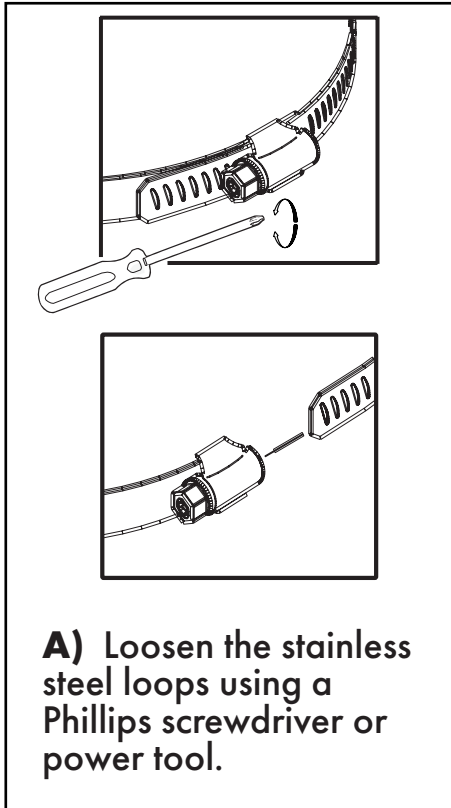


**C)** If needed, use cable ties to neatly manage and secure power or network cables. Once you are done, you can follow the WM-1 instructions to complete the mounting of the PTC series camera.

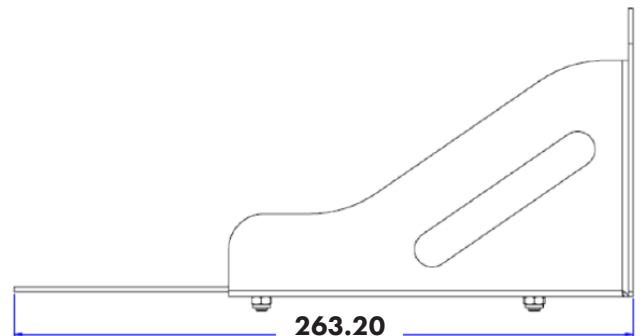
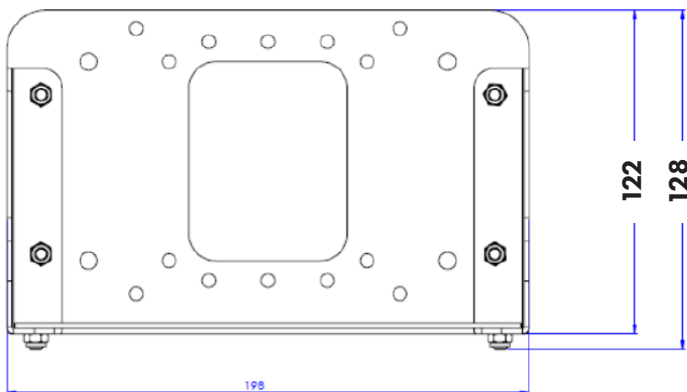
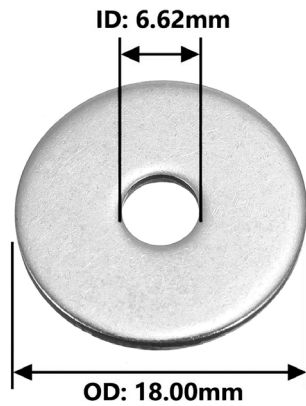
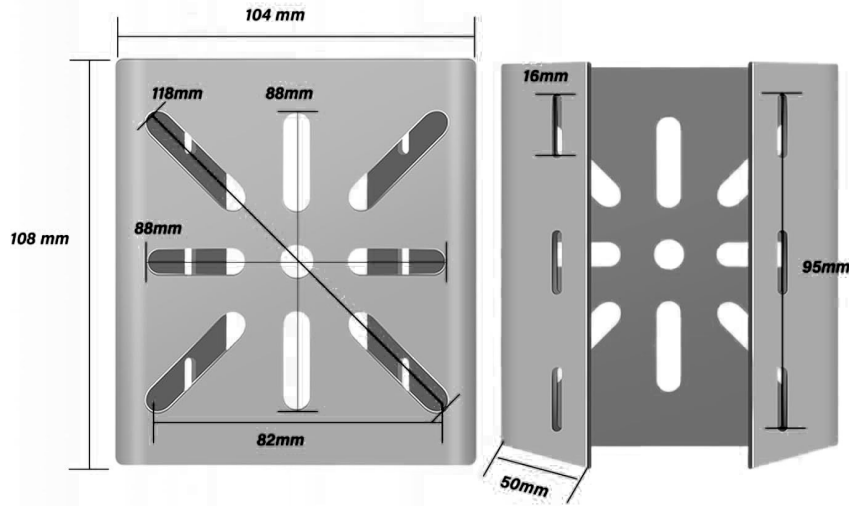
- The stainless-steel hoop edges are sharp—always wear gloves during installation.
- Ensure all screws and loops are tightened firmly to prevent movement or slippage.
- Verify that the pole is strong enough to support the total load of the bracket, WM-1 mount, and the PTZ camera.

# WM-1 Quick Installation

## How to install Datavideo PTC-150\* to WM-1

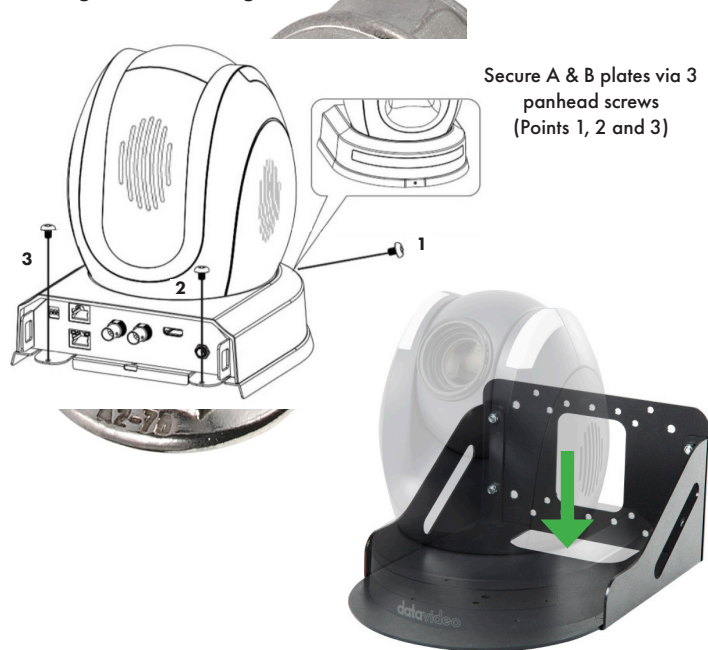
**Step 1.** Mount assembled WM-1 to the wall.

**Step 2.** Secure the PTC-150\* to the Ceiling Bracket A plate (**Figure 1**) by screwing 3 screws as shown.

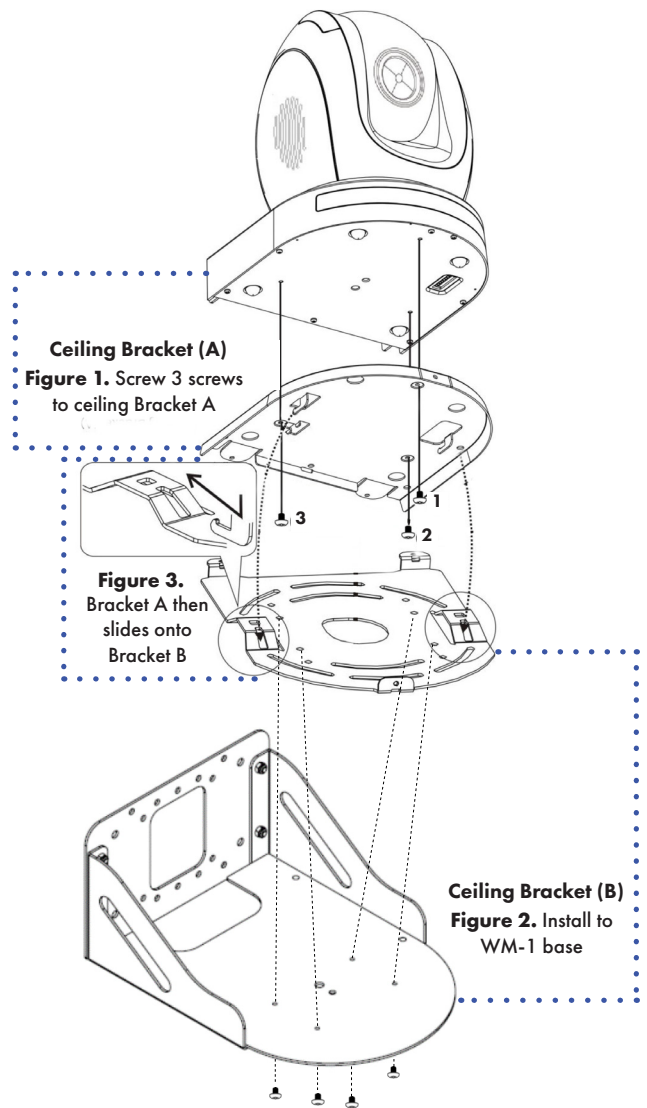
**Step 3.** Mount the Ceiling Bracket B plate to the WM-1 base as shown in **Figure 2**.

**Step 4.** Once the PTC-150\* is mounted to Bracket A plate, Slide it to Bracket B attached to the WM-1 base (**Figure 3**)

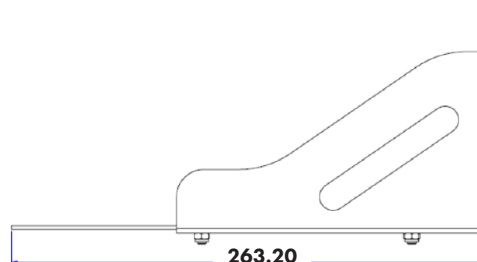
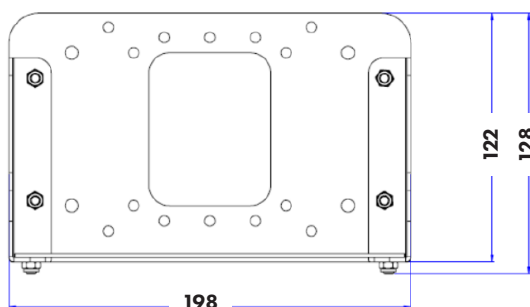
**Step 5.** Secure the camera to the A & B plates with 3 panhead screws as shown below. Then connect the cables through the rectangular hole on the WM-1 as shown below.
