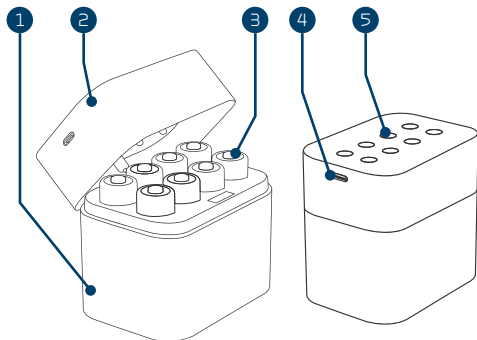
Please read and follow these instructions and keep this manual in a safe place.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- Do not charge any battery other than AA rechargeable lithium-ion batteries. Other types of batteries can burst, risking personal injury and damage.
- Do not disassemble the charger. Improper use may result in electric shock or fire. Take the charger to a qualified service technician when service or repair is required.
- The charger and batteries may feel warm during the charging process. This is normal.
- Do not operate the charger if it has received a sharp blow or has been dropped or damaged in any way.
- Never expose the charger to any moisture.
- Do not use an extension cord when using the charger. This may result in fire or electric shock.

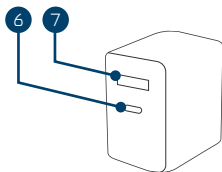
- Never use the charger as a DC power source for any electrical equipment.
- Always unplug the charger from the AC outlet before handling the batteries.
- Unplug the charger from the AC outlet before attempting cleaning and clean with only a soft, dry cloth.
