

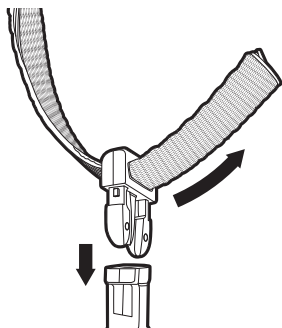

Cotton Camera Straps

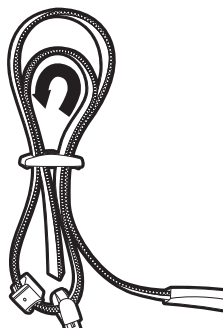
There are three ways to connect the camera strap to your camera: the micro quick release, 3/8 in. connector, or split ring.

ATTACHING THE MICRO QUICK RELEASE

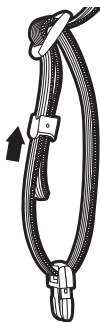
1. Disconnect the micro quick-release connectors. Unthread the strap from the slip lock buckle, then thread it through the male end of the quick release.



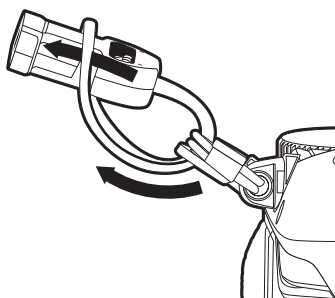
2. Rethread the strap through the slip lock buckle and adjust to the desired length.



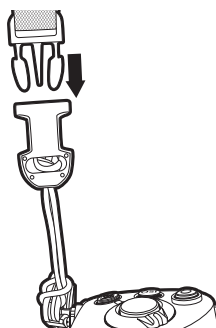
3. Use the slider to secure the excess strap.



4. Thread the loop of the female end of the quick release through your camera's strap mount, then thread the female end through the loop.

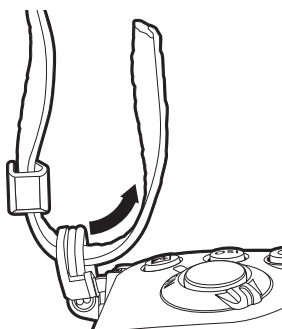


5. Reconnect the micro quick release.

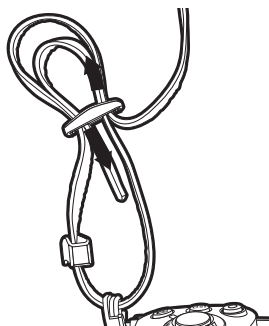


ATTACHING THE 3/8 IN. CONNECTOR

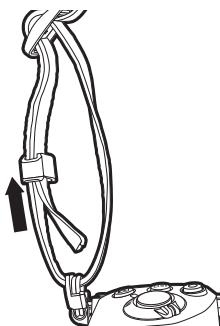
1. Unthread the strap from the slip lock buckle, then thread it through your camera's strap mount.



2. Rethread the strap through the slip lock buckle, and adjust to the desired length.

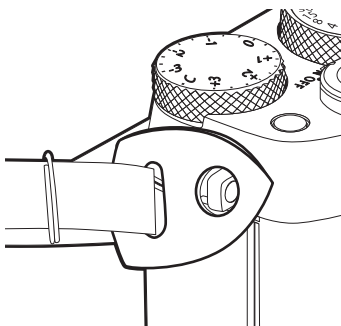


3. Use the slider to secure the excess strap.

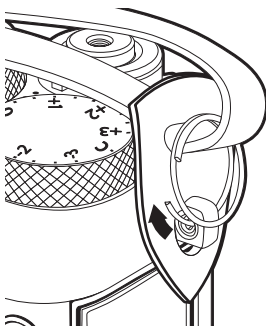


ATTACHING THE SPLIT RING

1. Push the leather pad onto your camera's eyelet.



2. Thread the split ring onto your camera's eyelet.



3. Continue to thread the split ring until it's fully attached.
