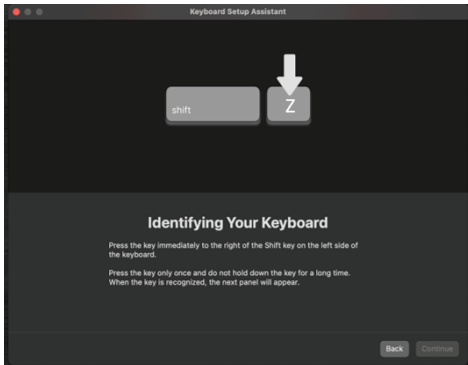


KEYBOARD SETUP ASSISTANT

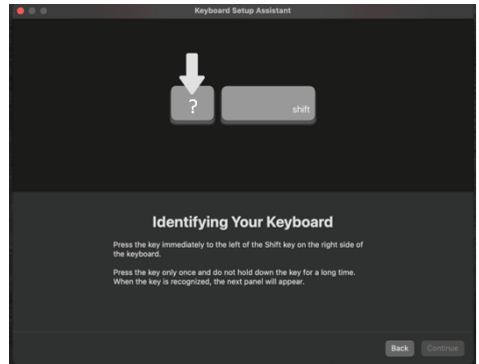
When you connect a keyboard that is not immediately recognized, the macOS Keyboard Setup Assistant automatically opens so that you can specify the keyboard type. Please follow the onscreen instructions when prompted.

If the Keyboard Setup Assistant did not popup and you are having issues with keys not responding or typing letters other than what's printed on the them you will need to launch the setup assistant manually by doing the following:

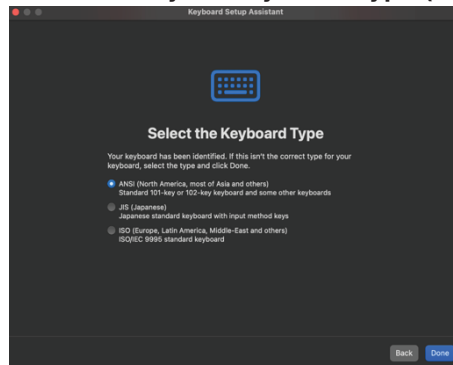
STEP1: Press the Z key



STEP2: Press the ? key



STEP3: Select your keyboard type (ANSI)



1. Open your System Settings or System Preferences.
2. Select Keyboard, then look for and click "Change Keyboard Type".
3. When you see the Keyboard Setup Assistant window, click Continue and follow onscreen instructions.















TOP F-ROW SHORTCUTS

The keyboards top F-row is defaulted to boot up under shortcut mode (small icons printed on the F-row keys) play, pause, volume up, etc.

NOTE

You can switch the F-row from shortcut mode to function mode F1-F12 at any time by pressing fn+esc which will then illuminate the FN lock LED indicator in blue color. When switched, you can still utilize the shortcuts by holding down the fn key followed by the shortcut you would like to perform. You can always switch the keyboard back to shortcut mode by pressing fn+esc again.


Below is a table of what each shortcut does.

 esc	Switches the keyboard between shortcut mode to function key mode as described in the above note.
	Decreases the brightness level on the screen. Please note that not all external monitors support this function.
	Increases the brightness level on the screen. Please note that not all external monitors support this function.
	Mission control.
	Spotlight Search
	Home (iPad)
	Previous Track
	Play/Pause.
	Next track.
	Mute.
	Volume down.
	Volume up.
	Eject/On-screen keyboard toggle (iPad)
	PrtScn (Windows)

fn + Return	Enter

fn + Down Arrow	Page Down
fn + Left Arrow	Home
fn + Right Arrow	End

How to change fn globe settings in Mac

The 'fn globe' key is a multi purpose key. You can change what it does from settings.

1. Click on Settings.
2. Click on Keyboards.
3. Look at chart below

Press Globe key to	Start dictation
Press Globe key to	Do nothing
