Instructions

Thank you for choosing Impact.

The Impact VE-CBA2 adapter makes the Venture TTL-600 monolight compatible with most flash-head accessories that have Bowens mounts. The adapter is easy to add to the TTL-600's integrated comet mount and securely locks into place in seconds.

Attaching the adapter

1. Unscrew the Venture's accessory locking knob and set it aside. **1**
2. Align the Venture's mounting pegs with the slots on the inner ring of the adapter. **2**
3. Fit the adapter onto the Venture TTL-600. Twist it clockwise until it stops.
Note: You may need to pull out locking knob to make sure the adapter fits snugly onto the Venture's comet mount. **3**
4. Screw the locking knob into the threaded hole at the top of the Venture TTL-600. Make sure the locking knob screws completely into the hole so the washer is flush against the adapter. **3**



To remove the adapter: Unscrew the locking knob, twist the adapter counterclockwise until it stops, and slide the adapter off of the Venture.

Instructions

Using a Bowens-mount accessory

1. Align the attachment lugs of the Bowens-mount accessory with the grooves of the adapter.
2. Insert the Bowens-mount accessory and rotate it clockwise until the lock clicks. 4

To remove the Bowens-mount accessory: Press the release tab toward the monolight, turn the accessory counterclockwise, and slide it off the adapter. 5
