OVERVIEW



ATTACHING THE BATTERY HANDLE TO THE BATON

1. Align the XLR connector with the pins on the bottom of the Baton.
2. Press the battery pack onto the Baton, and turn the locking ring clockwise to tighten until secure.

To check the remaining power in the battery pack, press and hold the power indicator.

4 lights	Fully charged
3 lights	75%
2 lights	50%
1 light	25% or less. Recharge the battery.

REPLACING THE POWER CELL

1. Unscrew the bottom cap, and remove the spent power cell.
2. Insert the new power cell with the battery contact facing inward.
