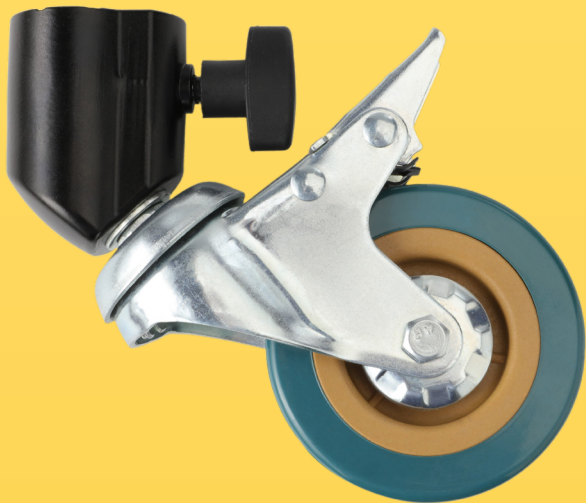

Introduction

Thank you for choosing Impact.

The Impact Locking Wheel Set fits on most tripod or light stand legs with 22 mm (LSA-LW22P) or 25 mm (LSA-LW25P) diameter tubes. The wheels feature sturdy construction, easy-to-operate wheel locks, and metal brake shoes that assure a tight and secure connection. The three-inch rubber wheels are easy to roll, even on thick carpeting, and won't scratch wood or polished surfaces.

Setup

Attachment Instructions

1. Install the brake shoe by sliding it into the receiver's notch. Make sure the post is at the bottom of the receiver.
2. Fully insert the tripod leg into the receiver until it touches the post
3. Tighten the knob until secure.



Locking and Unlocking the Wheels



To lock the wheels, press or step down on the locking lever.



To unlock the wheels, use your toe to push back the release tab on top of the wheel.
