Tilting the Camera



- 1 Less tension lets you rapidly change the camera tilt.
- 2 Greater tension lets you control the camera for a precise, slow camera tilt.

Panning the Camera

Use the pan feature to swivel the camera a full 360°.



- 1 Increase tension for slow panning motion.
- 2 Decrease tension for more rapid pan to follow action like passing cars or people.

Changing the Camera Orientation



- 1 The plate can be angled anywhere between 0° to 90°. This lets you instantly change the camera from landscape to portrait orientation.
