Cleaning and Maintenance

- Avoid any vibrations and shocks.

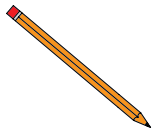
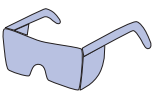
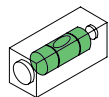
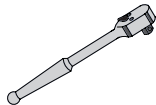

VESA 400mm x400mm(15.7in x 15.7in) Wood Stud

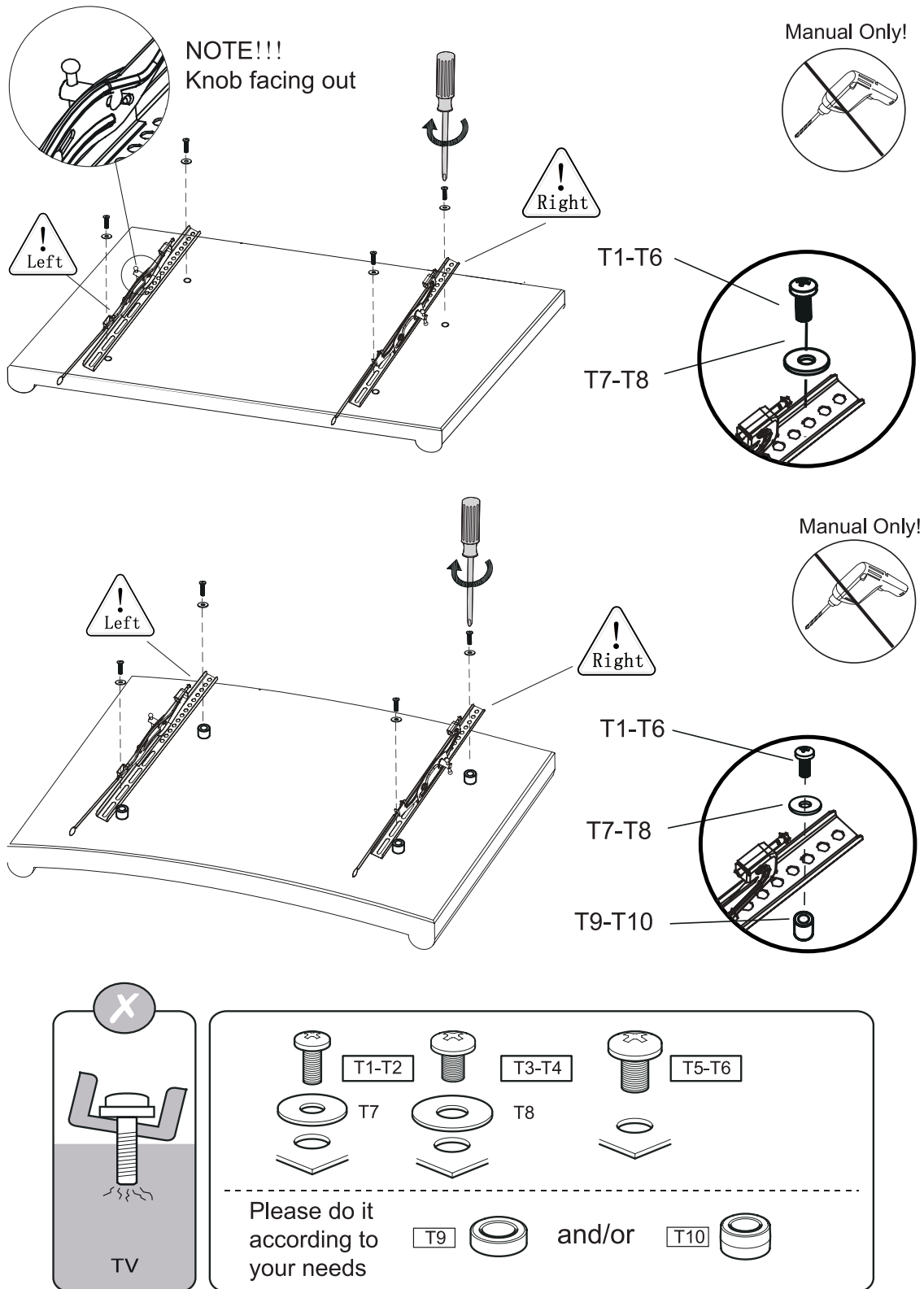


VESA 800mm x400mm(31.5in x 15.7in) Wood Stud

Two people are recommended to install the mount.

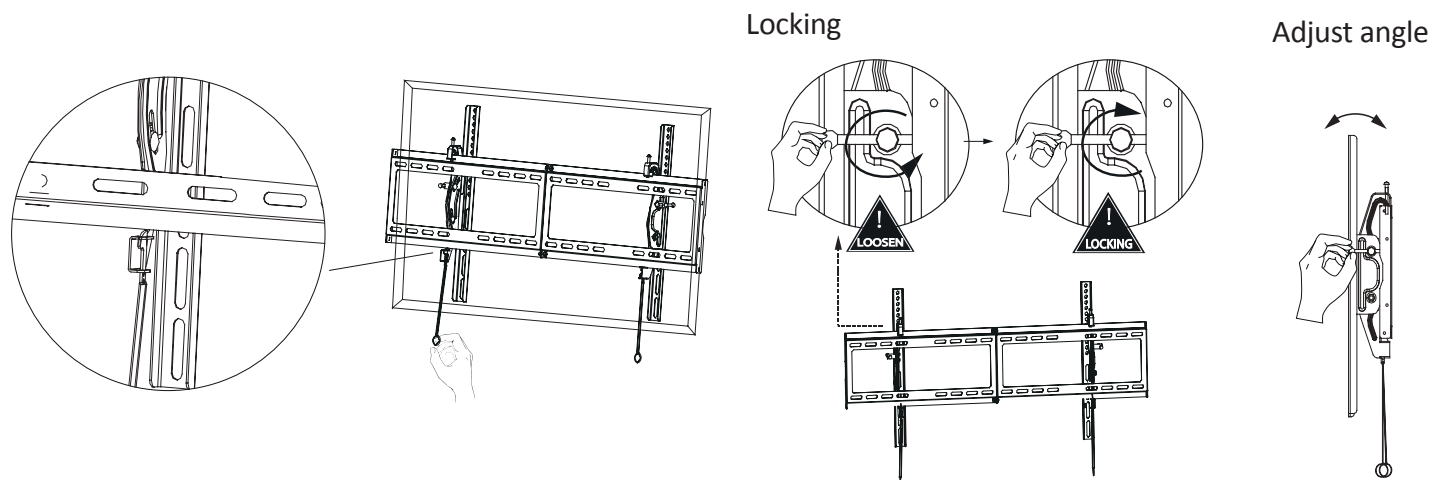


Note: after the upper hook is hooked, push the TV back until the safety lock is tightened, as shown in the picture.

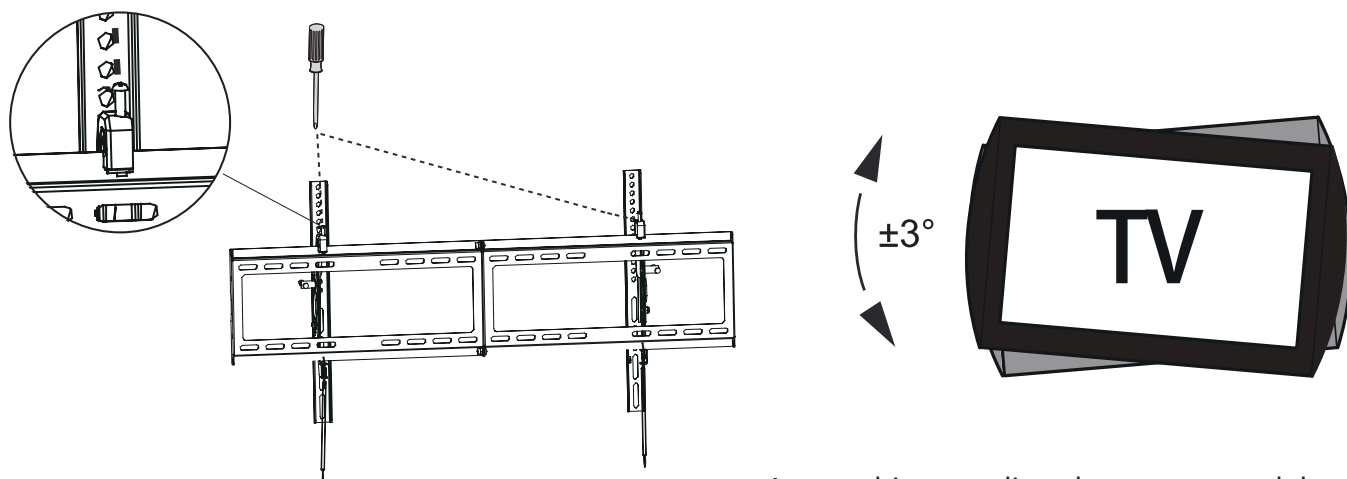

Note: if you need to remove the TV, pull the safety lock pull down until the safety lock no longer holds the wall panel, as shown in the picture.



Step 10

Horizontal angle adjustment



A screwdriver to adjust the screw, control the tilt angle of the TV, the angle can be controlled at $\pm 3^\circ$.
